The Saskatchewan Association of Optometrists (SAO) supports regulated dispensing. It is a patient's right to take their prescription and fill it as they feel fit. However; to ensure safety and accuracy of eye glasses and contact lenses, online purchases should be provided through a controlled environment. To this end SAO recommends that optometrists recommend to their patients the following three requirements of dispensing whether purchases occur online or otherwise.

- 1. A current and valid prescription for eye glasses secured from an optometrist must be verified as a valid prescription.
- 2. Current and valid contact lens specifications prepared by an authorized, regulated eye care professional
- 3. Patients should be provided access to personal fitting and adjustments of eye glasses by a regulated eye care professional

When the internet is used in the provision of spectacle therapy websites must:

- Comply with the bylaws of the SAO regarding advertising guidelines
- Identify the website as belonging to a member registered with the Saskatchewan Association of Optometrists
- Collect and record patient information in a private and secure manner as outlined in the Health Information Protection Act
- Identify the physical location of the clinic including the address and the hours of operation
- Include the telephone number to contact the clinic
